REQUESTED ACTION:

This report is intended to provide the Members of the Osteopathic Medical Board of California (OMBC) with an update on the probation program. No action is needed.

Total Numbers of physicians on probation

As of today's date, there are 32 licensees on active probation.

Five (5) are tolling out of state and not receiving credit towards completion of probation.

Review of cases

Quarterly reviews are being conducted, all information and documents are being recorded and documented in a full report. As a result, all probationers have received a quarterly review to discuss their specific terms and conditions.

Non-Compliance

One (1) probationer was found to not remain in compliance and has received a cease practice order which will remain in effect until compliance is met and or a petition for revocation will be filed.

Diversion Program

Four (4) licensees on probation are participating in the Board's Diversion program.

During the last Board meeting it was relayed that there were several matters regarding the communication between the diversion program and the OMBC. It is important to clarify that the issues that were found were administrative issues not related to participant compliance. Director Calderon and I have discussed these concerns with the diversion program and the matters have been resolved.
