REQUESTED ACTION:

This report is intended to provide the Members of the Osteopathic Medical Board of California (OMBC) with an update on the probation program.

No action is needed.

Total Numbers of physicians on probation

As of today's date, there are 31 licensees on active probation.

Five (5) are tolling out of state and are not receiving credit towards completion of probation, 26 are actively being monitored and are practicing medicine in California.

There are also Two (2) physicians who have received public letters of reprimand and are being monitored by the probation unit for course activity completion.

Review of cases

Intake and quarterly reviews are conducted both in person, via zoom or telephone with each physician to discuss their specific terms and conditions. All information and all documents are analyzed, recorded and documented in a full report. The Osteopathic Medical Board's Probation unit has maintained an effective and thorough accountability of our physicians on probation.

Non-Compliance

Three cease practice orders have been placed on licensees that have violated their probation. In addition, the Board has filed two petitions for revocation due to probationary issues.
