Complaints submitted to the Board may be investigated by the California Department of Consumer Affairs' Division of Investigation on behalf of the Board.



- 1. Click on "License Verification" on the home page.
- 2. Click on the **Search Online** hyperlink.
- 3. Choose license type: Click the checkbox for "Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon" and then "Search by Name."
- 4. Enter the doctor's last name and first name, then hit "Search."
- 5. Click on their name. Review license details, including verifying whether any disciplinary actions are listed at the bottom of the page.
